The Board of Education supports the development of staff inservice programs which will improve the instructional opportunities for the district's students. Viewing staff inservice as an integral part of the total educational program, the Board shall provide for varied staff development opportunities which will aim to further the district's educational objectives. On-site graduate courses sponsored by area colleges, after-school inservice courses and early dismissal programs will be offered upon the approval of the Superintendent and the Board.

Each active teacher shall be required to complete 100 clock hours of State-approved continuing professional development and/or in-service every five years pursuant with N.J.A.C. 6:11-13.1 et seq. Professional activities/meetings referenced in this Policy must be included as a State-approved experience, as recommended by the Professional Teaching Standards Board (N.J.A.C. 6:11-13.4) and approved by the Commissioner of Education to satisfy the 100-hour requirement.
