STUDENT USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES

The Board of Education regards the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by pupils as an assumption of responsibility by those pupils - responsibility in the care of property, the observation of safety rules, and the display of courtesy and consideration toward others.

The Board will not permit the use of mini-bikes or motorcycles for pupil travel to and from school. The Board will not be responsible for bicycles or motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.

Bicycles

Because of the clear and present danger of accident in traffic inherent in bicycle riding, it shall be the policy of the Board to prohibit the use of bicycles by students to travel to and from those schools so listed by the principal. Use of bicycles by students where permitted shall be in accordance with the rules of the district.

Motor Vehicles

The Board will permit the use of motor vehicles by pupils in grade 12 in accordance with district rules provided that such pupils are licensed drivers, have successfully completed a course in driver education, have been granted permission by the building principal to drive a motor vehicle on school grounds, and present written parental approval.

The motor vehicle operated by a pupil must be registered, have passed inspection by the Division of Motor Vehicles, and be properly insured.

The principal may revoke a pupil's permit to operate a bicycle or motor vehicle on school grounds for failure to observe district rules.

Motor vehicles used for travel to and from school must be parked in designated parking spaces on the school grounds and may be used during the school day only by permission of the principal.

Regulations will be included in the student handbook.
