SCHOOL DAY

The Board of Education specifies the times that school will be in session for the purpose of ensuring adequate instruction for the pupils of this district.

The regular school session may be temporarily altered when such alteration is feasible and advisable in the best interests of the children of the district by the Board of Education upon recommendation of the Superintendent.

The Superintendent may close the schools, delay the opening of school, or dismiss school early for emergency reasons and to protect the health and safety of the students and staff members, and shall prepare rules for the proper and timely notification of concerned persons in the event of any such emergency closing.

Children shall be permitted to enter school fifteen minutes before the start of class.

The Board of Education directs the Superintendent to cooperate with religious institutions by permitting early dismissal to those students whose parents wish them to have religious instruction.
