Dear Parent/Guardian,

Please be advised that full day kindergarten registration for the 2019-2020 school year will be held by appointment only during the month of **February 2019**. To be eligible for registration, your child must be **five (5) years old on or before October 1, 2019 for kindergarten**. Please call the elementary school assigned to your residence for an appointment date and time. Evening registration will be by appointment only on Wednesday evening February 13, 2019 from 6:00 pm – 9:00 pm for two working parent families and single parent families. A listing for each elementary school is attached for your information.

Ten of our twelve elementary schools will house at least two sections for full day kindergarten. Due to limited classrooms Cooper and Grissom will each offer only one section of kindergarten with the second kindergarten section being housed at Memorial School for Cooper students and Carpenter School for Grissom students.

Incoming kindergarten students for Cooper and Grissom who currently have siblings attending those two schools will be given priority to attend Cooper and Grissom kindergarten. **Registration for these students must be completed by February 22, 2019 to be given priority consideration.** Cooper and Grissom kindergarten students attending Memorial and Carpenter will return to their home schools for grade one.
