Old Bridge High School will be operating on an early dismissal schedule for these days.

Students involved with this test include:

- ***Grade 9 students – NJSLA - ELA & Math (Algebra I, II and Geometry)***
- ***Grade 10 students – NJSLA - ELA & Math (Algebra I, II and Geometry)***
- ***Grade 11 students – NJSLA – Science (all levels)***
- ***Grade 12 students – Senior Activities***

On each of the above dates, transportation will be provided as usual. All students will be dismissed at 11:42, per the early dismissal schedule.

As the state requires that test elements remain secure, cell phones or other electronic devices may not be brought to the testing rooms. Unfortunately, should the school be cited for testing irregularities due to the behavior of your child, any fine incurred will be your responsibility.

Students taking the test will report directly to their testing rooms at the Main Building and GNC. Students must arrive by 7:35 a.m. Grade 12 students will report to the auditorium at 7:35 a.m. for alternative activities.
